Award Amount and Conditions: \$1,000 per year, renewable each semester while in an undergraduate program. In order for the award to be renewed, the student must maintain at least a 3.50 cumulative GPA with at least 12 credit hours per semester. (Renewal is also subject to the PBK Association having sufficient resources.) Within two weeks of the end of each semester, the student must submit the ASU transcript to the address below for our review of the GPA and credit hours. The scholarship can be used for any educational expense (tuition, housing, books/supplies, etc.).

### To be eligible for the scholarship, an applicant must:

- Have completed at least 30 credit hours at ASU.
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50.
- Be in the College of Liberal Arts and Sciences.
- Have a demonstrated financial need (as determined by FAFSA).

- Personal statement describing:
  - Personal and family background.
  - Education and career goals.
  - How this scholarship will assist in achieving your education and career goals.
- Copy of your most recent transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable).
- Copy of your current FAFSA.
- A copy of a graded writing assignment from an ASU course. Include the course name and the name of the instructor.
